

Building the new Le Bonheur Children's Hospital was a community effort. The 610,000 square foot facility was constructed by 2,316 individuals who worked more than 1.7 million hours. Now the largest children's hospital in Tennessee, Le Bonheur was designed by FKP Architects, built by Skanska USA and made environmentally efficient by Johnson Controls. Also, at least 33 local companies were hired to assist with the project.
