

Patient with foreign body in the esophagus

Purpose:

To facilitate the transfer of a patient with a foreign body in the esophagus to Le Bonheur Children's Hospital. The patient can be "automatically accepted" if the following criteria are met:

- 1. Patient needs to be hemodynamically stable
- 2. All menarche females have a negative pregnancy test (Le Bonheur does not have OB services)
- 3. Confirmed that the foreign body is in the esophagus and not in the airway, stomach or intestines)
- 4. Confirmed that the foreign body is not a button battery

Process:

- 1. Call the Transfer Center at 901-287-4408.
- 2. Transfer center will obtain patient's demographic information.
- 3. Provide recent set of vitals (temperature, blood pressure, pulse oxygenation and pulse).
- 4. If PediFlite is needed for transport, please inform the transfer center.
- 5. If you want to speak with an ER physician for any reason, please inform the transfer center and they will promptly connect you with a physician.

Recommended Treatment:

- 1. Patient should be kept NPO
- 2. Normal Saline bolus 20 cc/kg; Max Dose 1 Liter
- 3. Maintenance IV fluids (example D5 NS)
- 4. Morphine 0.1 mg/kg IV (max dose 4mg) q2hr PRN pain
- 5. Ondansetron 0.1 mg/kg IV (max dose 8 mg) q8hr prn nausea/vomiting
